PERMITTED TECHNIQUES: All including photography – Must be printed in A4 min. *Photos may be submitted in black and white or in colour.*

Art can be in Any Medium – Must be min A4 (If on paper/canvas unframed, min size A4)

NB: *Each entry must have a tag on the Back with the following info: Title, Artists' name and address, Description of the Art work / photograph (5–10 lines max.), e-mail address (if applicable) and submission category. This should be attached in a non-permanent way to the back of the entry so that the entry will stay anonyms for judging purposes.*



CLOSING DATE: Entries close at midnight on Monday 08 May 2023. No late entries will be accepted.

IMAGE RIGHTS: Participants certify that their work submitted does not infringe other parties' image rights and that they grant SABIO copy right to use the images on its website and in the South African Bee Journal.

JUDGING PANEL: The judging panel will comprise artistic judge Amanda Buchnall from the South African Honey Judges Guild and artist Hannah Paine from KZN, as well as 1 guest judge (to be confirmed) whose decision will be final.

PRIZES: The prizes will be confirmed closer to the competition closing.

CONTEST RESULTS: The winners in all categories will be announced on World Bee Day 20 May 2023 at the Howick Golf club in conjunction with the KZN BeeFarmer's Association Golf Day.

PUBLISHED: Winning Entries (Placed 1st – 3rd) in all categories will be show cased in the Honey Hall during the Royal Show to be held in Pietermaritzburg from 23rd May – 05th June. In addition to this, all these winners will be published in the South African Bee Journal. Each photograph/artwork will be credited to its Artist and will include the description submitted.

RETURN OF NON-WINNING ENTRIES: All non-winning photographs and art works submitted on paper/canvas will be returned to the artist at the owner's expense at the end of the exhibition if so requested on submission.

All non-returned photographs/ Artworks will be added to SABIO's archives and credited to the author.
